# COVID-19 RESPONSE LEVELS

## LEVEL 1

0.00%-4.99%  
ACTIVE CAMPUS CASES

### WISD RECOMMENDS:

- Face coverings when indoors at JWE, DJH, and WHS and on buses
- Daily self-monitoring and screening for symptoms
- Proper and frequent handwashing and use of hand sanitizer
- At least 3 feet of social distancing in classrooms and other indoor spaces; when possible this may include desk configuration that increases distance

### WISD STAFF and FACULTY WILL:

- Evaluate all large (more than 1/3 of campus population) indoor gatherings within the instructional day (ex. pep rallies could be moved outdoors)
- Ask that all visitors and guests not enter our campuses without an appointment
- Continue daily intensive sanitation procedures by our custodial department
- Utilize podding techniques where possible (students in consistent small groups)
- Continue use of Safe Breathing Zone Units and air circulation systems
- Provide desk shields/dividers upon request

## LEVEL 2

5.00%-9.99%  
ACTIVE CAMPUS CASES

*All Level 1 protocols will continue to be utilized.*

### WISD STRONGLY RECOMMENDS:

- Face coverings when indoors at JWE, DJH, and WHS and on buses
- Daily self-monitoring and screening for symptoms
- Proper and frequent handwashing
- At least 3 feet of social distancing when possible
- Use of hand sanitizer

### WISD STAFF and FACULTY WILL:

- Move all large (more than 1/3 of campus population) indoor gatherings within the instructional day outdoors, or cancel the gatherings
- Not allow visitors and guests to enter campus; unless necessary
- Provide outdoor lunch options for students when possible
- If the test-confirmed, COVID-positive rate at a campus reaches 10% or higher the district will discontinue in-person learning at that campus and instruction will be offered remotely for a period of 5 to 10 days.

## LEVEL 3

10% OR HIGHER  
ACTIVE CAMPUS CASES

## LEVEL 4

- If the test-confirmed, COVID-positive rate at ALL campuses reaches 10% or higher, the entire district will shut down in-person learning at all campuses and instruction will be offered remotely.

### CLUSTER PROTOCOL

If at any time a class has three (3) or more test-confirmed positive cases, the Hays County Local Health Department has given WISD two options:

- The non COVID-positive class members will be quarantined away from school.
- OR -
- The non COVID-positive class members can remain on campus provided they wear face coverings for a specified amount of time.

**\*NOTE\*** Face-coverings are not mandated, parents have the option to keep their students at home until the quarantine time period has elapsed. All quarantine-related absences will be excused and daily work will be provided.
