As Spring Break begins here in Wimberley ISD we want to share information with our community regarding the Coronavirus pandemic and provide you with the latest information regarding school safety measures and procedures.

During Spring Break, we will continue to monitor the situation closely and will remain in contact with the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), the Governor's office, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the Texas School Safety Consortium, Hays County Emergency Management, and our school board president. Additionally, our custodial staff will utilize the break to continue using a hospital-grade disinfectant to clean our buildings – a practice that we have used for months now.

As this rapidly evolving situation changes we assure you that making the best decisions for the well-being of our students, staff, and community is our highest priority. In light of this, WISD will make a decision on the status of our school operations for the week after Spring Break (Mar. 23-27) no later than 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, Mar. 19. If the decision is made to extend Spring Break an additional week, it would include the cancellation of all UIL events, athletics, field trips, after-school programs, and other campus activities.
