AP Courses: Wimberley High School students consistently score well above the State & National average on AP Exams. Courses offered are Biology, Calculus AB, Chemistry, English Language & Composition, English Literature & Composition, Physics B1, U.S. History, World History, U.S. Government, Studio Art, and Environmental Science. Wimberley High School offers honors courses in all core classes leading up to AP courses.

Dual-Credit Courses: Austin Community College Courses offered are English Composition I & II, British Literature I & II, U.S. Government, Economics, Introduction to Psychology, and Introduction to Sociology. We also offer UT OnRamps Statistics and Computer Science.

ACT & SAT Scores: Wimberley High School students consistently score well above the State & National average. Average ACT score is 22.7 & average SAT score is 1119.

GPA/Class Rank: Calculated on a weighted 4.0 scale with extra points given to Honors, AP & Dual-Credit courses.
