## Accelerated Instruction

A student will be permitted to take an exam to earn credit for an academic course or subject area for which the student has had no prior instruction, i.e., for advancement, to accelerate to the next grade level. The exams given by the district are approved by the district's board of trustees, and state law requires the use of certain exams. If a student plans to take an exam, the parent must register and pay for the exam with the principal by May 3rd. The test will be held on June 4th and 5th at Scudder Primary. ## PRE-K & KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

It's time to register for the 2019-2020 School Year. We will have an evening registration event for all incoming Pre-K students on 4/2 from 5:00-7:00. Scudder Open Enrollment Week is April 15-18, with an evening registration event for Kindergarten students on 4/16 from 5-7.

New and returning students must register online. If you have moved and are trying to update information, you will have to come in and bring a new proof of residence before you can complete the registration process.

**We offer several pre-k options:** Our tuition based pre-k program is a full day program for 3 & 4 year old students. The cost is \$530.00 per month for 3 year olds (space is limited), and \$500.00 per month for 4 year olds. A non-refundable registration fee of \$200.00 is required to reserve a spot.

**We offer a half day pre-k program for qualifying three year old students at no cost.** Students must be three years old by September 1, 2019, and qualify by meeting one of the criterion below. **Scudder will continue to offer full day pre-k for qualifying four year old students at no cost.** Students must be four years old by September 1, 2019, and meet one of the criterion below.

**Qualifying criterion:** 1. Unable to speak or comprehend the English language. 2. Be eligible to participate in the National Free/Reduced Lunch program. 3. Are homeless. 4. Come from a family whose parent or official guardian is "active-duty" military, or whose parent/guardian was killed or injured while on active duty. 5. Have been in the conservatorship (foster care) of the Department of Family and Protective Services. 6. Is the child of a person eligible for the Star of Texas Award as a peace officer, fire fighter, or EMS responder.
