Dear Applicant:

Enclosed is an application for a Wimberley Community Civic Club (WCCC) scholarship. The WCCC is very pleased to continue this tradition of offering financial aid to students from Wimberley area schools with a record of achievement who need financial assistance to pursue their educational goals beyond high school. Your application will be considered whether you plan to attend a traditional university or a qualified non-traditional institution of higher learning such as a culinary or art institute or a trade school.

If you are interested and believe you are eligible, please submit the completed application to your guidance counselor (<u>and no one else</u>) by **Wednesday, March 27, 2024.** Applications must be on time and complete or the application will be disqualified immediately. In addition to the application, you must submit the following:

- A copy of your high school transcript certified by a school official
- A copy of the first page of your parents' latest income tax return, social security numbers blacked out
- Three letters of recommendation, at least two of which are from school personnel
- A resumé (including the items mentioned on page 4)
- An essay discussing your academic and career vision, and how you plan to use this scholarship. This essay should be a minimum of one page, double-spaced.


Financial need is the most important criterion for award of financial aid, so please be sure to explain why you need the scholarship to achieve your goals.

If you have any questions, please talk to your counselor. No one from WCCC may talk with you or your parents about the application.

Awards will be announced on May 2nd. If you are awarded a scholarship, you must comply with one more step: By August 15, 2024, you will be required to supply WCCC with proof of enrollment, such as a school ID or class schedule. If you fail to comply with that requirement, you will not receive the money. In addition, we request a report on how you are doing at the end of your first semester.

For your application to be considered, you must submit the following by the application deadline:

Completed application, including check-off page
 A copy of the first page of your parents/guardian's 2023 income tax return, social security numbers blacked out
Copy of your transcript
A resumé that includes:
*School and Community Activities
*Work Experience
*Positions of Responsibility/ Leadership
*Honors/ Awards
 An essay discussing your academic and career vision. How do you plan to use this scholarship? How do you see yourself 10 years from now? This essay should be a minimum of one page, double-spaced.
 Three letters of recommendation, at least 2 of which are from school personnel.
